

## Where to apply for your Amsterdam Parking Permit for disabled people

You can use the application form to apply for your Amsterdam Parking Permit for disabled people. This form is available at your local urban district council buildings and at one of the service points of the City Surveillance Service, or you can download it from the website given below. You can also ask for a copy if you ring the municipal information line: 14 020 (Antwoord ©). The call charges are the same as local rates. No area code is necessary.

## Something is changing in Amsterdam

A great many parking permits for the disabled are stolen from cars every year, and in order to combat this, parking regulations for the disabled in Amsterdam are being changed. From 1st July 2007, the familiar "Blue European Parking Permit for disabled people", will be valid only for parking spaces generally reserved for disabled persons. As a disabled person, however, you can continue to enjoy free parking anywhere in the city. In order to do so, you will need to have the Amsterdam Parking Permit for disabled people, which may be ordered free of charge.

## Apply for the new parking permit now

Apply as soon as possible to be sure that you will have the new digital Amsterdam Parking Permit for disabled people in time. You can ask for the application form by ringing the municipal information line: 14020 (Antwoord ©). Fill in the form and send it, together with a copy of your ID, a copy of your Blue European Parking Permit (front and back), and a copy of

your vehicle registration certificate Part II/1b or a copy of the Canta insurance form, to:

As soon as your details have been processed, you will receive official confirmation of the decision stating that the digital Amsterdam Parking Permit for disabled people has been granted. From then on, you will be able to park free of charge at all normal parking spaces in Amsterdam without having to display your Blue European Parking Permit on the dashboard by your windscreen.

## Save your Blue European Parking Permit for disabled people!

Your digital Amsterdam Parking Permit is not valid for general disabled persons' parking bays. If you wish to make use of these, you will have to display your Blue European Parking Permit on the dashboard by your windscreen.

Please bear in mind that the parking regulations for Blue European Parking Permit holders differ depending on the municipality and the country you are in.

Emma de Boer likes to shop in the city. She has already got one. "I am no longer afraid that someone will come along and smash my window to steal my badge. My car's registration number is stored in the computer, and that is all it takes with a digital parking badge. One less worry to cope with."

## Drivers, passengers, visitors

- Like all parking permit holders in Amsterdam, you – as a driver – will receive a digital parking permit. This parking badge is valid for two years and is linked to your car registration number.
- As a passenger, you will still (for the time being) receive a printed parking permit listing no more than three registration numbers. This badge is valid for two years.
